



TIPS for HOME SAFETY

Be House Smart - Play Your Part

Movement sensor light –

Sensor lights illuminate the approach to your house at night, as well as dark areas used as cover by thieves. They also increase the chance of detection, and therefore deter potential thieves.

Front Fence –

The front of your house should be visible to neighbours and passers-by, with an unobstructed view of your front garden. Do not allow offenders to use your front fence as cover.

Trees and shrubs –

Trees and shrubs should not obstruct the view into your property. The canopy level of trees should clear the ground by at least 2.5 metres.

Garage doors –

An open garage door is an invitation to thieves. Keep your garage doors, back and front, closed and locked

House Number –

Your house number should be clearly visible from the street to allow for quick identification in an emergency. Your house number could also be painted onto the kerb.
