Be House Smart - Play Your Part

Muddy Work Boots –

Muddy work boots on the front porch give the impression that a male person is home.

House Keys –

Do not leave keys hidden under doormats, pot plants, in the letterbox, etc. Instead, leave them with a trusted neighbour.

Windows –

Your windows can provide a shopping inventory for thieves. Fit curtains or screens that limit the view of people from outside, but allow you to see out clearly. Venetian blinds should point downward to the outside.

Gravel Path –

A gravel path or driveway can provide early warning of persons approaching your house.

Alarm System –

This can be an effective deterrent. Your alarm should have both visual and audible warnings and be linked to a monitoring agency. Have a battery back up system to your alarm and remember to change the battery regularly.
