



## TIPS for HOME SAFETY

# Be House Smart - Play Your Part

### Collectables –

Display expensive collectables in a secure lockable cabinet. If possible, mark each item. Photograph and record details for identification to aid recovery.

### Wall Safe –

Avoid obvious positions, such as behind a picture, for your wall safe. Think of a creative place and don't reveal its location to others.

### Floor Safe –

A safe affixed to the floor or embedded in foundations can save your important documents and expensive items. It should be well concealed and not left open for convenience. A fire-resistant safe adds protection.

### Roof/Ceiling –

The manhole cover should be sturdy and bolted securely from inside or underneath into the manhole cover frame. Thieves can get into your roof, but if they can't open the manhole their plans are more likely to be frustrated.

### Smoke Detectors –

Smoke detectors are mandatory. They should be tested frequently and the battery changed once a year.
