Be House Smart - Play Your Part

Neighbourhood Watch Newsletter –

Keep up to date with what is happening in your local area by reading your NHW newsletter.

Safety Information –

Your NHW newsletter will contain information about local activities that may have an impact on your safety and security, as well as safety information for making your home more secure.

Bills –

Your bills contain personal information and account numbers and can be used as proof of identity in some situations. File your bills away rather than displaying them on the fridge, notice board or similar place.

Weapons –

In rare circumstances an offender may enter your home whilst you are there. The kitchen is the room most likely to provide an offender with weapons. Try not to display knives or other harmful objects.

Offender in Home –

If you become aware of an offender in your home, avoid the kitchen if possible as a disturbed offender may react to an unexpected presence and reach for whatever is readily available. Take no risks.
