



TIPS for HOME SAFETY

Be House Smart - Play Your Part

Security Screens –

Security screens, roller shutters or similar, provide a good frontline security and safety measure.

Warning Stickers –

These can be a deterrent for potential thieves and demonstrate that you are vigilant about security. Remember: thieves normally look for the easiest target.

Window Locks –

Fit windows with window locks for added security. Do not develop a siege mentality and put bars over your windows. In the case of an emergency, bars do not allow you to exit through the window.

Locks Keyed Alike –

Locks that are keyed alike allow you to have a single key for all locks. The key should be kept in a safe place, **not in the lock.**

Internal Lighting at Night –

When your indoor lights are on at night, ensure that your curtains or blinds are closed, so that no one can see inside.
